STATEMENT

“A photograph.

Not just an interesting scene, to be frozen onto a surface: a photograph.

One of the images that exist in me, though I don't know where, or with what features, to the point where I get a vibration in the real, and the framing scintillates so that the image takes on flesh and matches up with its internal trace, still latent a second earlier.

Except that ordinarily the realness stops vibrating well before I act. Faced with what could become a photograph, I need time. To observe necessity intensifying. To understand. To doubt. To let the image get infused with the knowing. Not to accept it being infused only with a flash of vision. The flash is essential, but I can't turn it into a photograph other than by postponing the gesture of execution until life reveals the kind of flash it actually is. It's often a fake; in which case, best do nothing. The innocent photographer? That's not me. I'd like it to be the case, but it's not. After all that, if I'm not dissolved in the confrontation, well then yes, I'll take the photograph.

What follows is a time of patience, worry, excitement, uncertainty as to whether the camera saw the same thing as me. Not to mention the randomness of chemistry. But I gradually slip into insouciance, and soon stop thinking about it. Then one day the film comes back from the lab in the post. I spread it out on the light table. Among the images that say just what they say, I seek a familiar form. An irradiation. When I find it, I'm raised up again, with a flash still more decisive than at the moment of pressing the shutter, by a vibration, a trace, a framing of the real, previously recognised, now sanctioned by a sprinkling of silver salts on nine square centimetres of polyester.

A photograph. I see it as an organ transplant. And I immediately recompose myself. Without even having had time to feel the wound, I'm healing myself. Less infirm now.”

BIOGRAPHY

Frédéric Lecloux is a Belgian-French photographer and writer born in 1972. His photographs are distributed by VU' Agency in Paris since 2003. Autodidact, he graduated at a later stage from the École nationale supérieure de la photographie in Arles (2016) and in Nepali language from the Institut national de langues et civilisations orientales in Paris (2021). He is the author of several books of texts and photographs, among which *To the Desert* (2022), *Territoires du cinématographe* (2022), *Nepal. Epiphanies of the Everyday* (2017), and *L'Usure du monde* (2008). All are published by Le Bec en l'air, a photobook publisher for which he also works as an associate editor. First guest of rn7's Les Nouvelles oubliées residency in 2019, he is also a recipient of the Leverhulme Trust Artist in Residence Grant (Great Britain) in 2016 and of the Cnap documentary grant (Paris) in 2015. He taught numerous workshops aimed at questioning the usages of photography with, among others, photo.circle (Nepal), the Rencontres d'Arles and in school context. He now guides photographers looking to turn professional, mainly through VU' Éducation. He runs a blog on which he posts translations, interviews, analyses and critical texts about photography.
